

'django pop / gypsy swing'

Swing à la Django is an innovative sixmembered band, who have created a special style-mix in their music harmonizing gypsy swing, authentic bossa nova, Hungarian folk music, French chansons, tango and jazz. This has resulted in a unique style that they call 'django pop' based on virtuoso instrumental improvisations mixed in many genres.

Their music is originally inspired by legendary Django Reinhardt, following the footsteps of Reinhardt by evoking the atmosphere of the 30s-40s and transfer it to today's modern music milieu.

the very beginning

Every story has a beginning and most beginnings are hard. The path to success leads through many and difficult attempts. On the road you will have companions who help you and envious who won't. But all the people who know what his purpose is and are willing to make sacrifices to achieve it, fate will bring the fulfillment of desire. This makes us beleive! In early 2000's Pal (Lombos) studied classical double bass as a student of Debrecen University of Music. He was the first musician in his family with no predestination from this side. But regardless, he has no doubt what he wanted to do with his life. He already had a completely definite idea about his future, which his companions sometimes smiled at, sometimes did not understand.

The dream was simple - one day he hasto stand on the same stage with his idols - Roby Lakatos, Margit Bangó and Stochelo Rosenberg. The goal was clear, but the road was long and difficult, through several different experiments and formations. He met many good musicians, got to know many exceptional people, and finally, in 2014, it seemed that there was light at the end of the tunnel, the band Swing à la Django was formed.

The inspiration was there - who could be more inspiring for an artist than Django Reinhardt, the guitarist who overcame the laws of physics and created something so unique that it is now considered one of the greatest classics by the profession and the jazz fans.



the Swing à la Django story

It was an idea of Pal Lombos, the head of the band Swing a la Django, in the Summer of 2014, to orchestrate the band's songs to a "big band formation" as this kind of music has not been played in Hungary before, and very rarely performed in other countries as well. The orchestration was successful, so the big band formation could debute in the great concert hall of MUPA in Budapest, on the 22nd of January 2015. Following this event the formation was immediately asked to give a concert of their own at Városmajor Open Air Theatre. Since then the formation has had great and even bigger success. The parts of the big band are, apart from the Swing a la Django's members, the Budapest Saxophone Quartet, the Corpus Trombone Quartet and the trumpeters of the Dohnányi Orchestra from Budafok.


